

Cardiology referrals must meet the following Medicare requirements:

Echocardiography

- · Symptoms or signs of heart failure
- Ventricular hypertrophy or dysfunction
- Pulmonary hypertension
- Valvular disease
- Pericardial disease
- Aortic disease
- Congenital heart disease
- Cardiac tumour or thrombus
- Cardiac source of embolus

Note: Only 1 GP referred echocardiogram can be performed every 2 years.

Exercise stress echocardiography

- New typical or atypical angina
- Known coronary disease with worsening symptoms
- ECG changes consistent with coronary disease
- Coronary CT or invasive angiogram lesions of uncertain significance
- Exertional dyspnoea of uncertain aetiology
- Silent ischaemia limited history of exercise tolerance
- Pre-operative assessment before valve surgery
- Severe valvular stenosis
- Severe valvular regurgitation
- Pre-operative assessment prior to MAJOR non-cardiac surgery

<u>AND</u> low functional capacity <4 METS <u>AND</u> presence of any 2 of:

- Heart failure
- Ischaemic heart disease
- Stroke/TIA
- Renal impairment eGFR <60
- Diabetes on insulin

Exercise stress test

- Symptoms of cardiac ischaemia
- First degree relative with suspected heritable arrhythmia
- Other cardiac disease which may be exacerbated by
- Car/Truck/Aircraft/etc licence testing (NOT covered by Medicare)

24 hour holter monitor

- Unexplained syncope or presyncope
- Palpitations (>1 episode per week)
- Suspected arrhythmia (>1 episode per week)
- Surveillance post cardiac surgery known to cause arrhythmia
- For detection of asymptomatic atrial fibrillation (AF) following a TIA or cryptogenic stroke

48 hour holter monitor

- Unexplained syncope
- Infrequent palpitations (<1 episode per week)
- Other symptoms where a cardiac rhythm disturbance is suspected and where infrequent episodes have occurred

7 day event monitor

- Unexplained syncope
- Infrequent palpitations (<1 episode per week)
- Other symptoms where a cardiac rhythm disturbance is suspected and where infrequent episodes have occurred

Respiratory function and EEG preparation guidelines and patient information

6 minute walk test – No preparation required

Respiratory function test – Inhaler medication may need to be withheld prior to test– see appointment letter

- Please wear shoes easy to remove as a height and weight will be required
- No smoking 1 hour prior to test it impacts the results
- No strenuous exercise 1 hour prior to test
- · If you have a FeNO booked no eating or drinking 1 hour prior to test and no antihistamines it impacts the results
- If you have a Mannitol booked withhold all inhalers, antihistamines and caffeine see letter for times

A respiratory function test <u>cannot</u> be performed if you have:

- An active respiratory infection (cold, flu, pneumonia, RSV, chest infection, COVID, etc)
- Recent surgery
- Recent pulmonary emboli
- Recent heart attack

EEG – Please bring a list of your current medications

- Please wash hair the night before. Do not put sprays, gels, mousse, oils in your hair
- · Fast for 1 hour before your appointment
- Wear comfortable clothing
- · For a child under 16 they are required to be sleep deprived please see appointment letter
