As a member of Medical Services, the appointee will contribute to the overall performance of the team consistent with Grampians Health Ballarat Mission, Vision and Objectives..











KEY ACCOUNTABILITIES

Clinical

- Provide specialist anaesthetic services, including appropriate perioperative care, within credentialed privileges to patients of Grampians Health Horsham at the relevant Grampians Health sites. This includes performing a share of on-call duties and responsibilities
- Ability to manage the full range of paediatric (over 2 years of age), adult & obstetric patients encountered
 at Grampians Health in elective & emergency anaesthesia. Experience in thoracic and vascular
 anaesthesia preferred.
- · Proficiency in ALS in line with Grampians Health medical staff requirements
- Be willing to undertake outreach anaesthetic services to other sites in Grampians Health.

Research & Teaching

- The Consultant Anaesthetist would be expected to participate in clinical research projects that the anaesthetic department is undertaking
- Participation in the departmental teaching program for ANZCA trainees (Ballarat site), as well as for HMOs and medical students (Melbourne University and Deakin University).

- Experience in clinical anaesthetic care across a wide range of surgical specialties, including paediatrics and obstetrics.
